About

Summer Camp Afghanistan (SCA) is a weeklong program that improves students' English language and leadership skills while simultaneously preparing them to apply to international scholarship opportunities and jobs through sessions on career development and study abroad.

SCA recruits 40 school students (20 males & 20 females), between the ages of 15-19 for one-week training and educational activities. The SCA staff-team are selected from college students with an international academic experience.



Our History

As the first summer camp in Afghanistan, SCA has been making a difference in children's lives since 2017. Connecting youth from Afghanistan with other youth in the world, SCA is a life-affirming journey that builds on the richness and power of lifelong values. We encourage young people to understand the values and skills they will need to become exceptional community leaders.

Our vision

We launched SCA with a vision of empowering Afghan youth and improving their English in an alternative educational environment.

SCA provides a safe and educational camp experience that changes the participants. They gain skills modeled by experienced leaders that are hard working, positive, and have something new to share with the community.



Outcome

At the end of the camp, students are able to write resumes, cover letters, and develop statements of purpose for getting scholarships for study abroad. They are exposed to group work activities that enhance their leadership, team building and critical thinking skills.
